Community Pharmacists: Can supply antibiotics for the following 7 conditions- UTIs, Impetigo, acute sore throat, shingles, infected insect bite, acute sinusitis and acute otitis media in children aged 1-17 years.

Minor injuries unit: You should go to the minor injuries unit if you have had an accident, and feel as if you have sprains, suspected broken bones and wounds.

NHS 111: 111 can direct you to the best place to get help if you cannot contact your GP during the day, or when your GP is closed (out-of-hours).

Depending on what you need, you might be advised to:

- Call 999 or go to A&E in an emergency
 - Go to an urgent treatment centre
- See an evening and weekend GP (out-of-hours GP)
 - Book a callback from a nurse
- Get urgent specialist support, for dental or mental health problems
 - Contact your own GP surgery
 - See a pharmacist for help with a minor illness
 - Look after yourself safely at home
 - Emergency prescriptions

Within the surgery

As part of our on-the-day duty team, we have paramedics who can provide care for various health matters.



Paramedic practitioners are trained to independently provide care that does not require the intervention of a doctor.

They report directly back to the GP with the outcome of their assessments and any updates on any treatment and medication that was given. Paramedics may be running clinics, triaging, and managing minor illnesses, and providing continuity for patients with complex health needs.
